The Birthday Offering grant will help renovate McCleary House for people experiencing homelessness. Poverty has been increasing in Maine, with a growing number of vulnerable people losing their homes due to job loss, eviction, sickness or economic hardship—all complicated in the last years by the pandemic. This transitional home will provide a warm and healthy place to live for 3-4 families or 6-8 individuals over the course of the year, as most guests stay just a few months. The renovated home will provide a safe space for individuals to begin the psycho-social, educational and vocational work needed to move forward with their lives.

Following Hurricane Maria in 2017 and the January 2020 earthquakes in Puerto Rico, the Presbyterian Church in Lares has become the go-to location in the community for food, purified water and personal items. With much of the population elderly and infirmed, they rely on the church for help with necessities. Because the church's kitchen is small, dated and not code compliant, upgrades are needed to continue providing this ministry. With funding from the Birthday Offering, all appliances, wiring, lighting and plumbing will be replaced and the facility will be made ADA accessible. Solar panels and a heavy-duty generator will be installed to provide uninterrupted electrical service and water availability.

## Session Highlights for April 2022

The April Session meeting was held April 5 in person the library/meeting room. Warren Jones led devotions and opened the meeting with prayer.

The *Clerk's report* indicated that Sunday worship in March continued to be in person but was also offered live at 10:30 AM through Facebook and available on the church's YouTube channel and website. The average sanctuary attendance in February was 60. Communion was celebrated on March 6 with Pastor Ed officiating. Ash Wednesday Service was held on March 2 with 31 in attendance for the service. It was noted that 55 people were served at the March 24 Community meal.

The *Treasurer's Report* for **February** was: Year-to-date income \$68,126.13; year-to-date expenses \$57,018.28; Checkbook Balance \$139,9220.05; available cash \$83,455.07; e-giving year-to-date \$6,210.30. **March report** was: Year-to-date income \$81,083.24; year-to-date expenses \$81,158.09; Checkbook Balance \$128,725.01; available cash \$72,272.40; e-giving year-to-date \$9,341.41.

The deacon's report was received with thanks. The deacons will be hosting a "Spring Fling" luncheon on May 22 following worship.

James Wilson and Troy Porter presented their faith statements and were examined by Session members. Their requests to become members of the Middle Spring Presbyterian Church were unanimously approved. They will be received into membership on Easter Sunday, April 17. Don Cover will serve as a mentor for Troy Porter and Quay Stolte will serve as a mentor for James Wilson.

Troy Porter, son of Megan and Troy Porter, and Noland Michael Evanchak, son of Ryan and Lindsay Evanchak, will be baptized during worship on Easter Sunday, April 17.

**BUSINESS:**

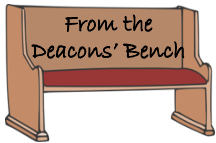
- Fellowship following worship will begin on April 24 and every third Sunday thereafter. Brett Chamberlin will be conducting Blood Pressure Screenings during the fellowship on April 24.
- The passing of the offering plates, fellowship pads, and passing the peace resumed during the month of March. Communion will be served in the pews beginning in April.
- The Chancel Choir will present their first anthem in over two years on Easter Sunday.
- Summer Worship hours will begin at 9:30 AM during the months of June, July, August, and Labor Day.
- The men of the congregation will serve the breakfast following the Easter Sunrise Service.
- The May Session meeting will be held on May 17 because of a conflict with the Presbytery Meeting.
- Discussion was held regarding how we can as a congregation and session help with the relief for the Ukrainian people. It was suggested that we ask the congregation for donation and the session will match those donations up to \$5,000. The agency or organization to receive the donation will be discussed later after research so that the Ukrainian people receive the entire benefit.
- The transition team gave a summary of what they will be presenting at the upcoming congregational gathering on April 21.
- A Study Leave for Pastor Ed was approved for April 18 through May 1.
- Contributions were distributed to several of our local mission organizations. In conjunction with the Partnership for Better Health and the Shippensburg Community Resource Coalition, a check was mailed to the Partnership for Better Health and the funds were matched by the Partnership and the Shippensburg Coalition.
- Mike Denning, Technical Personnel, presented a proposal for a new sound board system. This was tabled for further discussion at the May 17 meeting.

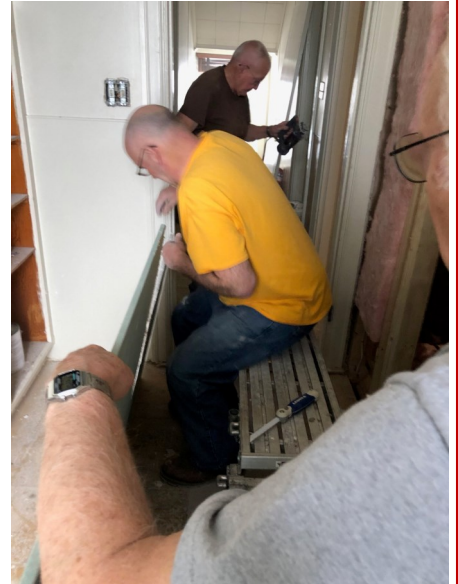


## Manse Renovation News

**PROGRESS AT THE MANSE: Manse Update:** Slow and steady wins the race. As with most renovations, your thought of completion dates and reality do not always match. We are continuing to work on completing the upstairs bathroom and bedroom. The spackling and sanding are in progress. The vanity is built and flooring purchased and ready for insulation once the walls are completed.

We have heard from the cabinet maker; he plans to start building our cabinets in early May. So, we need to begin demo on the kitchen, a workday is set for May 4th. We will demo the kitchen on Wednesday, May 4 starting at 8:00 AM. Lunch will be provided. Bring all the tools you think you may need - claw hammer, small saw (we need to open the floor so the electrician can do his work), sledgehammers, gloves, etc. The cabinets and paneling will need to be removed so the electrician can make the needed updates. 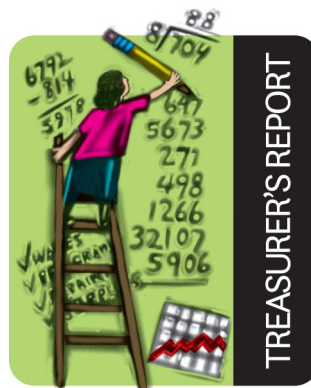
